Phamatech is the only manufacturer of in-vitro California licensed Clinical Laboratory (CLIA) waived diagnostic kits to have a federally licensed Substance Abuse Drug Testing Laboratory (SAMHSA) within the same campus.

Phamatech offers several CLIA waived diagnostic on-site drug testing products. Physicians can perform diagnostic tests in their offices, and if required, send the specimen to the laboratory for confirmation testing of prescribed compounds or additional drugs not detected by the on-site device. Physicians should verify reimbursements for on-site diagnostic kits with their insurance providers.

REQUISITIONS

Panels may contain from one drug to a comprehensive monitoring panel as determined by the physician. All laboratory tests include one or more specimen validity tests to ensure a proper specimen has been collected.

FOR MEDICATIONS:

The requisition form has a comprehensive list of current medications. Physicians should indicate which drugs the patient is currently being administered. The laboratory may then indicate on the report if the anticipated results were obtained based on the medications indicated.
